One Hinman publication that is still going strong today is *Dynamo*, Hinman College's very own yearbook. *Dynamo* was started in the mid-1970's by Bob Giomi who wanted to create a special yearbook only for Hinman. The campus-wide yearbook often overlooked a lot of events that were unique to the individual residential colleges and Bob saw *Dynamo* as a way to chronicle Hinman events in detail and give special honor to the residents of Hinman. *Dynamo* was named after the wooden Dynamo Monument located adjacent to the Hinman Commons building. Since at least 1975, *Dynamo* has documented every major event in Hinman, from Co-Rec, to HLT/HPC plays, to the Hinman College Council. It has captured in time Dorm Wars, Hysteria, Bus Stop and Rockefeller Room, Bandemonium and Open Mic. It has also captured candid photos of the more leisurely moments in the individual buildings and the floor pictures are constant reminders to everyone of the friends and the memories that they have made over course of the year. More than that, *Dynamo*, like the *Hinman Halitosis*, is an important historical document that chronicles the life of students in Hinman College. *Halitosis* is important for getting the nitty gritty details of life in Hinman, but as the saying goes, a picture is worth a thousand words, and the photographs in *Dynamo* are everlasting memorials to the students, staff and faculty of Hinman College throughout the years.
